





## **EXHIBITION ADOLPHE KEGRESSE, THE CRUISING GENIUS**

Rétromobile pays tribute to Adolphe Kégresse, a behind-the-scenes figure who revolutionised the automotive world.

- An exceptional and immersive display on the Pont des Expositions.
- A journey to the heart of Citroën expeditions on the 100th anniversary of the Croisière
  Noire
- Rétromobile 2025 pays tribute to Adolphe Kégresse, a pioneer of the automobile.

**Paris, 15 October -** Rétromobile 2025 is to shine a spotlight on Adolphe Kégresse, a prodigious inventor who marked the history of the automobile with his visionary innovations. This tribute will showcase his most predominant contribution: the half-track. This innovative solution provided vehicles with the opportunity to move around in extreme environments, in particular through snow and sand, and contributed to the development of automobile expeditions.

## An immersive life size display

Adolphe Kégresse left a lasting mark on the automotive industry with more than 200 patents registered. Through this display, several of his creations which have been hidden away for many years will once again be on display at Rétromobile 2025, where visitors will be able to admire various models of half-tracks, the symbols of the ingenuity of this adventurous engineer.

This first-time display, featuring several highlights, will put on show 12 exceptional Kégresse half-tracks. In addition to the 'civilian' versions, several flagship models will be presented, such as the Citroën Kégresse 10 HP model K1, the only half-track of its kind in the world, and used for the legendary Crossing of the Sahara, exhibited in partnership with l'Aventure Citroën.



The display will take the public on a deep dive into the famous **Croisières Noire** and **Jaune** (Black Cruise, Yellow Expedition). An immersive décor comprising sand, rock, bivouac and camping utensils will offer a backdrop to **certain vehicles** that went on these historical expeditions, such as the Citroën Kegresse P 19. Usually on show in the 24 Hours of Le Mans Museum, this vehicle took part in the Central Asia Yellow

Expedition between 1931 and 1932. Othe reconstructions will also retrace and recount the adventures of Adolphe Kégresse.







## Who was Adolphe Kégresse?

Adolphe Kégresse was born in 1879. As a young man, he developed a passion for all things mechanical, and moved to Russia where he worked for the company Lessner, the supplier of automobiles to Tsar Nicholas II, and where he quickly became head of the imperial garages. It was in Russia, faced with the challenges of tough winters, that he dreamt up an ingenious system: the half-track, to enable vehicles to get around whatever the weather conditions.

On his return to France following the Russian Revolution, Kégresse joined forces with André Citroën. Together, they would develop the vehicles with flexible tracks (known as autochenilles) that would power the expeditions of Citroën around the world, notably the Black Cruise and Yellow Expedition, which proved to be true technological feats and advertising coups in the 1920s and 1930s.
